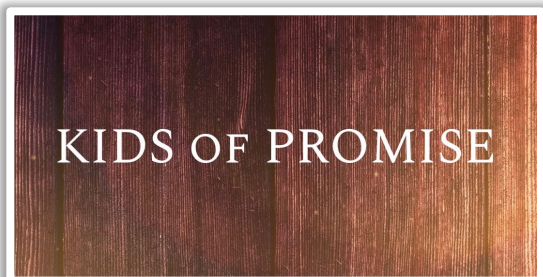
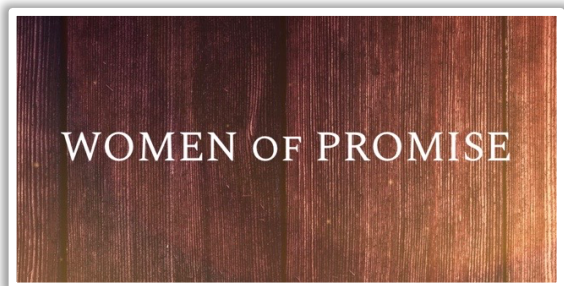

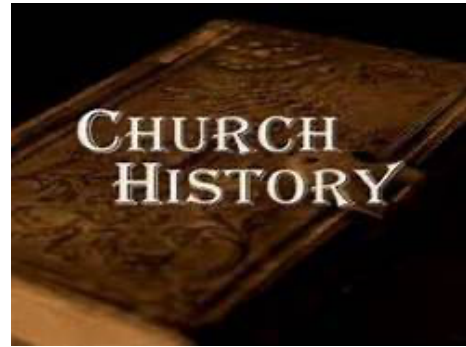
Faith Factory
